
# Enjoy five days of dramatic landscapes, historic granaries,



Arriving in the coastal city of Agadir, begin to get a taste of the the two worlds of Europe and Africa.

Take a little time to explore Agadir, whose name comes from the Berber word, agadir n irir ("the fortified granary"). Today this city is a major seaside resort crisscrossed by modern boulevards. Spend a restorative first night at the Sofitel Resort Agadir before the start of our unique and exciting journey, which includes daily working to protect Morocco's long-ignored granaries that form a tradition going back more than a thousand years.

# a day visiting granaries.

Heritage Fund projects: the Tiskmoudine and Isserghine granaries were two of the largest collective granaries in the 16th century. The third granary we visit today is the **Adghress granary**; its namesake village was founded during the Almoravid dynasty (1062–1150 CE) and predates Marrakesh. While here, we'll visit a women's cooperative and hear how local craftswomen are taking an active part in protecting Morocco's unique historic sites.




